- Communicate early with the teachers to avoid bigger problems later

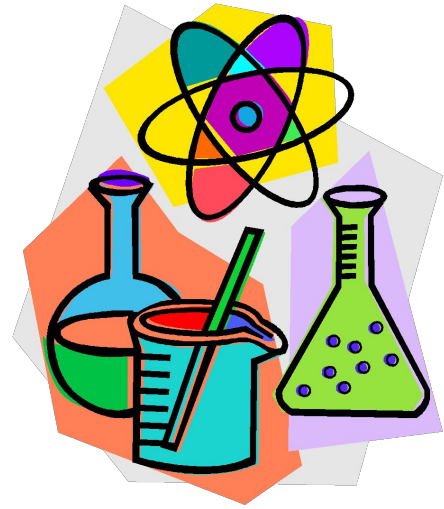
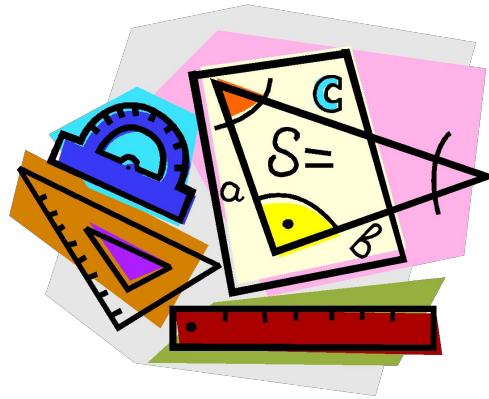


Infinite Campus/Parent Link

- Grades - updated and LIVE!
- Need to have current numbers in system
- Auto dialer with messages from school
- Come into front office for password information
- Must be active on Infinite Campus to request a conference

Google Classroom for Students

- Assignments
- Tests and quizzes
- Notification of upcoming events/projects/etc.
- Students can communicate with the teacher
- Students can communicate with each other asking questions
- Assignments sync with Calendar so student due dates should populate automatically so parents can stay informed if checking with their child

Expectations

- Students will have more work in junior high
- The work will be harder and more extensive
- They will be expected to turn things in on time. Rewards for NO missing work!
- They will be expected to ask questions
- They will be expected to seek help when needed - SELF-ADVOCATE
- They will be expected to follow directions
- They will be expected to do their best

Chromebooks

- Paperwork read and signed by both parent/guardian AND student BEFORE distributed - in **packet**
- Used both at school and home for assignments
- Needs to be charged and brought to school each day - leave charger at home
- Appropriate use - digital citizenship
- Parents need to monitor home use
- GoGuardian used to monitor student use
- \$25 technology fee
- Paperwork and fee needed **PRIOR** to getting Chromebook

Phones and Lockers

- NO cell phones in classrooms, halls, locker rooms, gym, etc. (confiscated if used)
- MAY be used before and after school - outside of campus
- No photos taken during school unless directed by teacher
- Lockers are school property - need to be kept clean and free of anything the student is not supposed to have
- Lockers can be searched at any time
- Don't leave food or water in lockers (BUGS!)

Parent Expectations

- Check backpacks/binders for notices and work
- Check Garrett web page for information
- Check Infinite Campus regularly
- Assist the child but don't do the work
- Communicate with the teachers
- Teach child how to advocate for themselves
- Monitor all social media
- Call or email when there is a concern

Conflict vs. Bullying

- Teach children to BE KIND
- Severe one-time event or repeated or pervasive action
- Interferes with the rights of a person
- Physical harm or damage to property
- Written, verbal, physical or combination
- Cyberbullying - monitor social media and cell phones
- A one time name calling is NOT bullying
- NRS 388.122
- If we don't know about it, we can't help fix it

BULLYING.

Attendance and Tardies

- Students need to be in school
- If absent, send a note the next day
- Truancy letters are mailed home if no note (letters after 3, 6 & 9 unverified absences)
- Citation after third letter
- Tardies - no excused tardies
- If late 30 minutes or more, they are absent
- Consequences for tardies - lunch, after school detentions, meeting with the dean
- Rewards for NO tardies

Straight A Luncheons/All Os

- All As for the quarter
- Special invitation to a luncheon
- Past luncheons: Panda Express, Subway, School BBQ, Green Valley Ranch buffet
- All Os earn an ice cream treat at lunch
- Always a huge hit for those kids who work hard

Honor Cards for 2nd-3rd quarters

- Earned for getting As and Bs with no Ns or Us
- Early out before lunch -1-2 minutes*
- Early out on Fridays - 1-5 minutes*
- Special events and activities for Honor Card holders

Passing both ELA and Math State tests earns one for the 1st quarter

*Early outs are at the discretion of the teacher

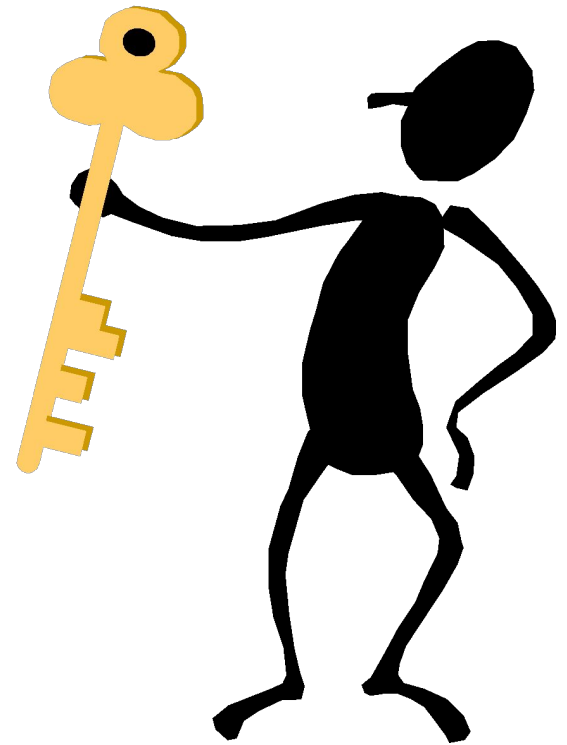
