Bookmark Contest: The library and ELA teachers will have blank bookmarks available for decoration. Students must decorate the bookmark incorporating the theme, “**Find Your Super Power, Read**” into the design and submit it to the library by **Friday, March 1st at 2:10 p.m.** One winner for each grade will be selected by a judging committee and will receive a prize. Book marks may either be black and white ink or color.

“Selfie” Photo Contest: Students, teachers and staff are encouraged to take a selfie with a book for our reading week “selfie” photo contest and share it with Mrs. Coppola at coppore@nv.ccsd.net. Make sure **your book is clearly featured in the “selfie” with you.** Selfies will appear on the Garrett Library Instagram. The top “selfies” will win a prize from our reading week prize table. “Selfie” entries need to be submitted to Mrs. Coppola by **Friday, March 1.** There will be one 6th, 7th, and 8th grade winner.

Trivia Questions: Students and teachers will listen to Nevada Reading Week themed trivia questions on the daily announcements. If ANYONE (not a class) knows the answer to the trivia question, he or she must write down the answer on a sheet of paper and bring it to the library before 3rd period that day. Students must write his or her answer on a piece of scratch paper with his or her name and grade. Mrs. Coppola will draw **one** correct answer from each grade level each day. The winner will receive a treat. All winners will be **announced during Lunch Period.** There will be one 6th, 7th, and 8th grade winner each day.

Poetry Contest:

Calling all Bobcat poets! We’re on the lookout for poems of all styles – rhyming, free verse, haiku, and more – for the 2019 Nevada Reading Week Poetry Contest! Create a poem around the theme “**Find Your Super Power, Read**”. Poems must be submitted to Mrs. Coppola in the library by **2:10 on March 1st.** One winner from each grade will win a prize.

Poetry Contest Guidelines:

1. Poems can be rhyming or non-rhyming.
2. Poems must be written around the reading week theme: “**Find Your Super Power**”. Submit your poem in print to the library, or if you prefer, you may share your submission with Mrs. Coppola at coppore@nv.ccsd.net. Make sure you enter your poem by **March 1st at 2:10.** There will be one 6th, 7th, and 8th grade winner.

Teen Read Week Challenge: Explore reading by completing 150 points of the reading week challenge form. Get signatures when you complete activities. You must earn at least 150 points to complete the challenge and enter the contest for your chance to win. Turn your form into the librarian for your chance to win by **March 1st, at 2:10.**
